CODE OF CONDUCT**

PREAMBLE

It is expected that the members, exhibitors and visitors at the CHINCHILLA & SHADED CAT FANCIERS inc (the Club) shows will at all times adhere to the Club's Code of Conduct and act in a courteous manner to all other people they come into contact with while at the show. Breach of the Club's Code of Conduct may result in refusal by the Club to accept any future entries from the offender(s). By entering the Club's show, you are agreeing to abide by the Club's Code of Conduct.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- a) Any exhibitor or visitor causing annoyance by loud comments on the decision of the judges will, after having been cautioned by the Show Manager, be expelled from the show.
- b) Any exhibitor or visitor removing numbers, exhibits and exhibitor's property from the benches without the permission of the Show committee or its representatives will be asked to leave the show hall and, if the offender is an exhibitor all their prizes and awards will be withheld.
- c) No complaints about judging shall be made in the area of the judging. If an exhibitor has a complaint about results, it must be lodged in writing along with the relevant fee to the Show Manager.
- d) Any exhibitor or visitor soliciting on behalf of any organisation, club, or association without the permission of the Show committee or its representatives will be asked to leave the show hall and, if the offender is an exhibitor all their prizes and awards will be withheld.
- e) Any exhibitor or visitor using threatening, abusive, profane, insulting language or gestures to another person will be asked to leave the show hall and if the offender is an exhibitor all their prizes and awards will be withheld.

Exhibitors who are not COAWA members are reminded that you are required to send a copy of your cats/kittens registration with your show entries. For security reasons, no exhibit will be allowed to be removed from the show without the permission of the Show Manager.</p>
